

Rail Bridge structure replacements at Nazeing New Road, Broxbourne

I am writing to advise you that Network Rail and its contractor, J Murphy and Sons Ltd, are planning to carry out critical bridge structure replacement works located at Nazeing New Road, EN10. This work will be carried out in the area shown below:



This letter is intended to provide early notification and a brief overview of the planned works. We will provide more detailed notifications about the work in the coming weeks.

The Murphy project team will begin to assemble on site from **Monday 11th April**. Preparation works including vegetation strimming and scaffold construction will take place from this time.

The main work for the bridge demolition and replacement will take place over the weekends of 20/21 August and 27/28 August. A concrete pour will also take place on the weekend of 10/11 September.

The works will take place 24/7 at these times and will be noisy.

Nazeing New Road will be closed to all traffic and pedestrians from 6 June until the end of November 2022.

This sort of work often has to take place when trains are not running, including during the night and at weekends or holiday periods, in order to maintain the safety of trains, passengers, lineside neighbours and our staff. Some disturbance will, unfortunately, be unavoidable. Every effort will be made to minimise any unnecessary noise, and those working on site are briefed on working responsibly in the local community.

We will provide further detail of the works in the coming weeks.
