Nazeing Parish Council have secured a public meeting with the Essex Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner Office alongside representatives from Essex Police.

### The Commissioner's Statutory Responsibilities: -

- Setting the priorities for Essex police and Essex County Fire & Rescue service.
- Setting budgets and council tax precepts.
- Appointing and dismissing the Chief Constable and Chief Fire Officer.
- Holding the Chief Constable and the Chief Fire officer to account for their services' performance.
- Regularly engaging with the public and local communities.
- Allocating grants through the community safety development fund and commissioning local services.
- Bringing together community safety partners to reduce crime, Support victims of crime and keep people of Essex safe from harm.

In order to prepare for this meeting, we need to ask you to do the following: -
