### **Application for Closure of Nazeing Churchyard**

I am writing further to Revd. Helen's letter of 24 March 2021.

As so much time has elapsed, I am enclosing a new 'Form B(i)' along with a map showing the Churchyard boundary.

We are applying for closure on the basis that we are running out of space and there will soon be no further room for burials.

Members of the PCC met with representatives of Epping Forest District Council last year to discuss the closure and the extent of future maintenance.

Please would you arrange for question B4 to be answered and the form returned to us by post or email within 1 month from the date of this letter.

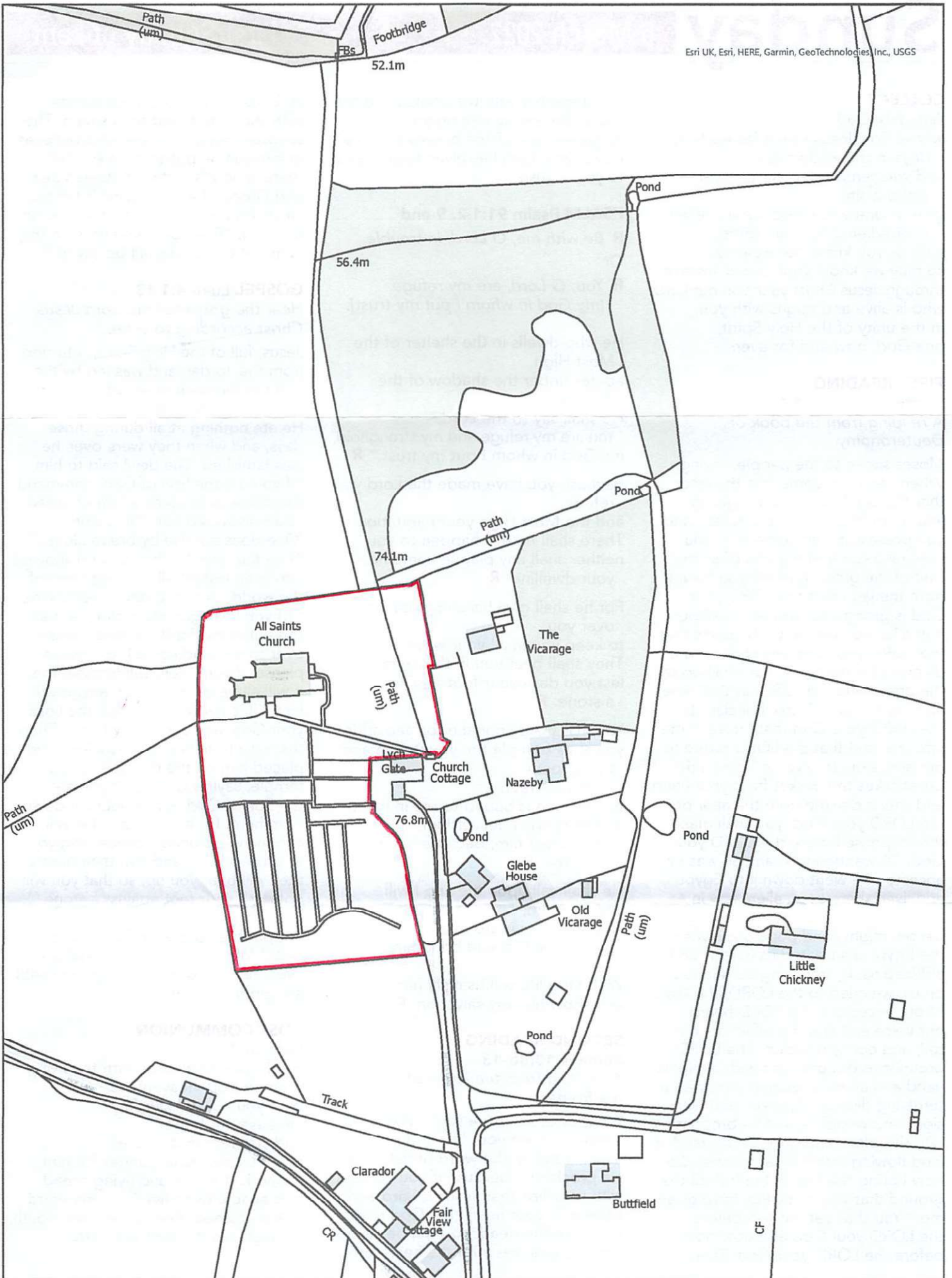
Whilst writing we would like to make you aware of the following points:

1. You may only object on the grounds at B1 i.e. you disagree with our assertion that there will shortly be no room for new graves.
2. We intend for burials to continue in existing graves and spaces reserved by faculty.
3. The Closure Order would have no effect on public access to the Churchyard.
4. If satisfied that the application can properly proceed, the Ministry of Justice will ask the Parochial Church Council to bring the proposals to the attention of local parishioners and to invite any comments to be sent direct to the Ministry of Justice.
